- open questions and persisting challenges related to the conduction and management of the course that you would like to be addressed in the seminar

Please feel free to insert images and screenshots from your course page or learning management system, where your course is located, to demonstrate your case study.

Be prepared to pitch/present your case study **in English, in 3 minutes**. As a starting point you can use [PechaKucha](#) presentation model,<sup>1</sup> where you present your course by showcasing different images and pictures.
